Economic Indicators

An economic indicator is a piece of economic data, usually of macroeconomic scale, that is used by analysts to interpret current or future investment possibilities or to judge the overall health of an economy.*

Economic Indicators to Watch

- 3. Median income
- 4. Population 25+ with associates degree or higher
- 5. Total population by age and race
- 6. Labor force participation rate
- 7. Income from self-employed workers
- 8. High school graduation rate

Comparative Communities

Comparable communities resemble our community in economic activity and investment. Comparative communities have similar qualities to the West Michigan Lakeshore Region, including high percentage of manufacturing, close to a body of water or tourism, and a Midwest feel. We've chosen some comparative communities for their aspirational qualities, including a higher net migration or desired livability for younger professionals and workers.
